Good parenting requires both teamwork and freedom. It requires enough teamwork to ensure not merely the support and back-up of another adult caregiver, but, more importantly, the benefits to the child of the contributions, skills, insights and perspectives of both human genders – male and female. Usually it involves the dedicated parental attention, affection, training and protection of both parents (Wardle: 2011). The disintegration of the family as a unit and the failure of its social roles because one or more of the family members are unable to fulfill the expectations and duties of their roles leads to dysfunctionality of the family. This highlights the importance of both parents in a family.
